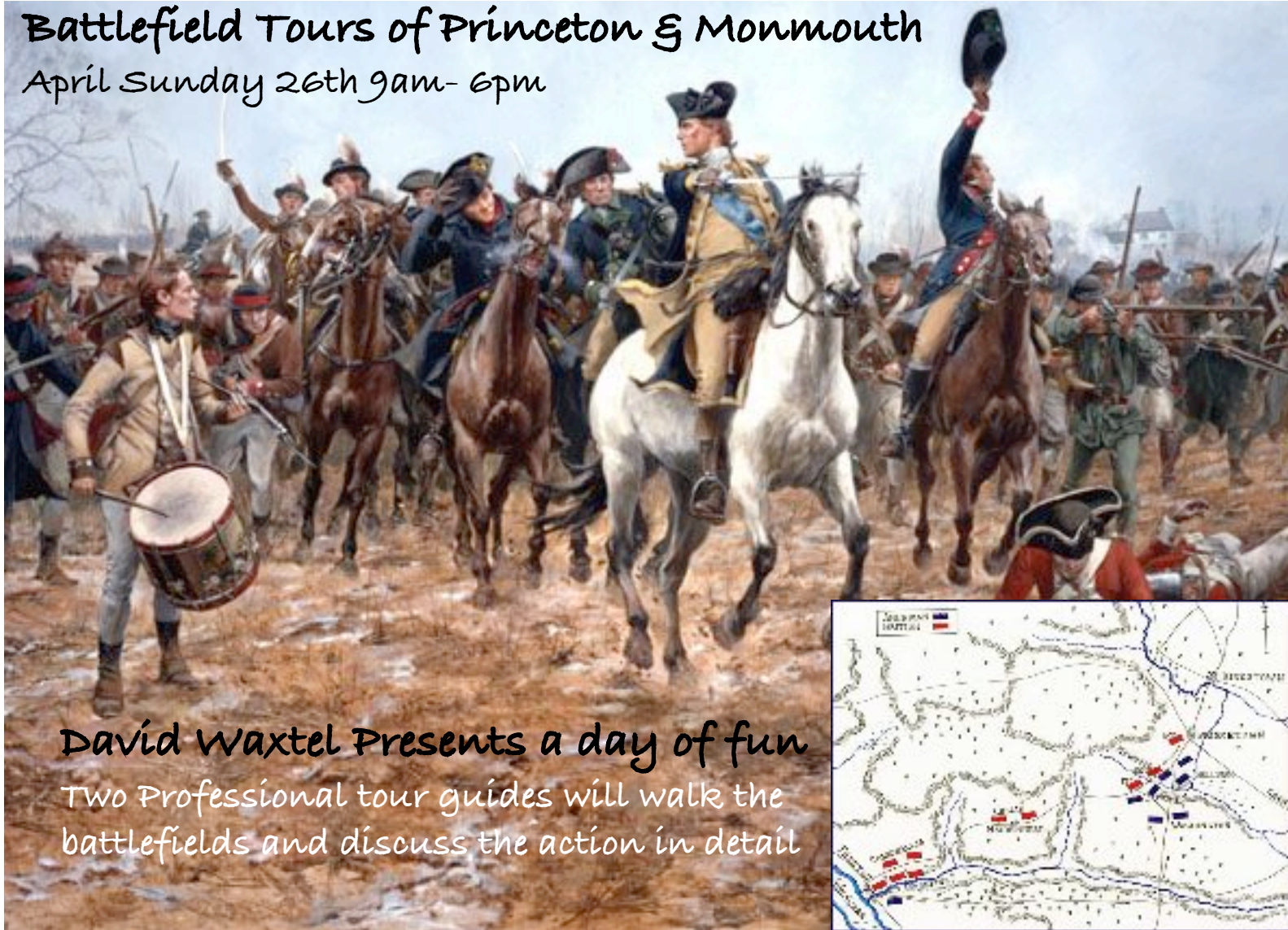


# Battlefield Tours of Princeton & Monmouth

April Sunday 26th 9am- 6pm



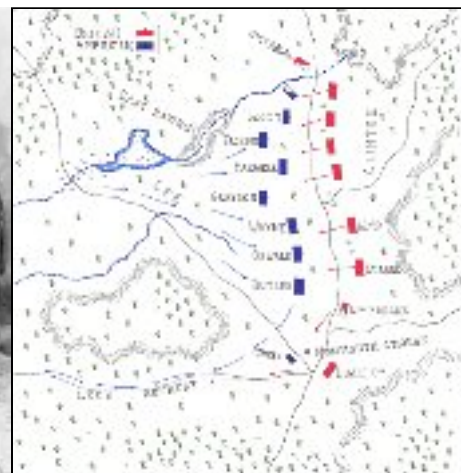
*David Waxtel Presents a day of fun*

The Battle of Monmouth was an engagement in the American Revolution fought on June 28, 1778. The American army of about 13,000 men, including 2,000 Jersey militia, was led by George Washington, who took a personal hand in the fighting, while the British, numbering some 10,000 troops, were commanded by Sir Henry Clinton.
